

SHORT NOTICE ACCREDITATION ASSESSMENT CHECKLIST FOR NON-CLINICAL STAFF

The following table contains a list of common questions an Assessor may ask non-clinical staff when undertaking an onsite accreditation assessment against the NSQHS Standards.

From the 1st July 2023, Allowah transitioned to Short Notice Assessments against the NSQHS Standards. What does this mean? We will only receive a minimum of 1 full business day notice that an accreditation assessment will commence. Assessors will be spending a minimum of 75% of their time out in operational areas, therefore the likelihood of an assessor speaking with you is high!
